Applicants should try to limit their answers to 250-300 words for each of the following questions. There is a total of 19 points available, and if further shortlisting is necessary, then the highest scoring applicants for question number 3 will be prioritised.

1. Why do you want to participate in the Summer School?

5 points available

(Please relate your answer to location, theme/activities and personal reasons, a full answer needs to mention more than one aspect)

2. What skills, experiences and/or personal attributes would you bring to the summer school?

3 points available

(The summer Schools are group experiences and participants will travel, work and live together)

- 3. What personal development goals and experiences are you hoping to gain from the summer school?

 5 points available
 - (This could relate to personal, academic or professional development, and a full answer needs to mention more than one aspect)
- 4. What do you see as your biggest challenge when taking part in the Summer School and what would you do to overcome it?
 3 points available
 (Applicants need to demonstrate awareness of challenges linked either to location, personal circumstances or activities)
- 5. As a participant on the Summer School, you will be an ambassador for LJMU and our Global opportunities. What will you do to ensure you reflect the University's core values and inspire others to go abroad with LJMU in the Future?
