A Rights Based Approach

- Put human rights at the heart of health and social care
- Provide staff with a framework of common values
- Engage and empower service users
- Improve the quality of care for patients, and careers (families)

Value of A Rights-Based Approach

- ❖ Advocacy tool: Open opportunities to have dialogues around sensitive and challenging issues; such as access to service, providing appropriate and responsive service etc.
- ❖ Accountability tool: Local authorities, commissioners and service providers provide transparent mechanisms to monitor and ensure appropriate and responsive service.
- ❖ Analytical tool: Help understand problems affecting asylum seekers and refugees.
- ❖ **Programming tool:** Help identify specific priorities and benchmarks and guide the process (e.g. 'minimum core standards')
